- Prepare or commit to prepare a climate action plan that includes actions in each of the ten Best Practice;
- Demonstrate compliance with AB 939, the California Integrated Waste Management Act of 1989; and
- Achieve the specified greenhouse gas emissions reductions, energy savings and complete best practices activities associated with each Beacon Award level.
