What is Covered?

- Regular checkups, including well-child checkups
- Immunizations
- Infant Care
- Prescription Medicine
- Lab and X-Rays
- Dental and eye care (including glasses)
- Mental health services
- Substance abuse services
- Physician and hospital services

How much does it cost?

Depending on the program your child or teen is eligible for, comprehensive medical, dental, and vision coverage may cost anywhere between \$0 and \$51 per month, per family.

What is Medi-Cal?

Medi-Cal is no-cost comprehensive health coverage for children and teens available through the state of California. It covers eligible children from birth to age 21. Medi-Cal provides medical, dental, and vision coverage.

Who is Eligible?

A child may be eligible for Medi-Cal if:

• The child or teen is a resident of California and is a U.S. citizen, U.S. national, or qualified immigrant, regardless of the parents' status.

Eligibility for Medi-Cal is determined by family income, size, and age of the child.





What is Healthy Families?

The Healthy Families program is lowcost comprehensive health coverage for children and teens available through state and federal funding. Healthy Families covers eligible children from birth to age 19 providing medical, dental, and vision coverage.

Who is Eligible?

A child may be eligible for Healthy Families if:

• The child or teen is a resident of California and is a U.S. citizen, U.S. national, or qualified immigrant, regardless of the parents' status.

• They are not receiving or eligible for no-cost Medi-Cal

• They have a Medi-Cal share of cost

• They are not currently covered by health insurance

Eligibility for Healthy Families is determined by family income, size, and age of the child.
