WHY RECYCLE?

STATE LAW NOW REQUIRES ALL APARTMENT COMMUNITIES/MULTI-FAMILY COMPLEXES WITH 5 OR MORE UNITS TO RECYCLE.

 A HEALTHY ENVIRONMENT FOR OUR COMMUNITY AND FUTURE

HOW TO GET STARTED?

- Use the information on the other side of this flyer to help your residents learn what they must do and what items can be recycled.
- Make sure residents separate recyclable items from refuse inside their home.
- Tell residents they must place recyclable items in recycling containers for collection.
- Make sure residents know where outside recycling containers are located.
