



# **Over State And State And**

### City Facilities: Energy Retrofits

- $\circ$  10 projects since 2010
- $\circ$  \$1.9 million EECBG + revolving loan
- 36%-50% energy savings per facility

### **Clean Energy Sacramento**

- PACE Financing Program
- Ygrene Energy Fund
- $\circ$  \$100 million investment
- $\circ$  1,500 jobs in 5 years
- 2012 Green Leadership Award
- $\circ$  Launching in 2012


# Water & Wastewater Systems

#### AMI Leak Investigation Program


- 1,000 field leak investigations in 2010-2011
- Water Wise House Call follow-up
- 236 million gallons per year saved

#### Water Wise Demonstration Garden

- Natives & drought-tolerant species
- Low-volume irrigation
- Educational signage, open to public
- 44% more efficient than previous landscaping







# **Green Building**

### LEED Silver Standard (City Bldgs)

- $\circ$  Adopted in 2004
- $\odot$  6 new facilities certified since 2005
- $\odot$  All >20% than Title 24 Energy Code
- $\odot$  2011 Green Leadership Award



### Streamline Sacramento

- $\circ$  Online / E-Permitting
- $\circ$  Solar Permit Fees & Guidance
- $\circ$  CALGreen implementation
- $\odot$  Best practices, communication



# Waste Reduction & Recycling

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### Green Yard Waste Program

- $\circ$  85% of customers using green bins
- Moving towards mandatory
- Composting, mulch
- Future green waste-to-energy?



### Multi-Family Recycling Ordinance

- Mandatory recycling
- Buildings/Complexes with 5 units +
- Solid Waste Authority (City/County)
- Rental Housing Association

# **Climate-Friendly Purchasing**



#### Sustainable Purchasing Policy

- $\circ$  Adopted in 2010
- $\,\circ\,$  Recycled paper & postconsumer content
- $\,\circ\,$  No bottled water!
- Green cleaning & janitorial supplies
- EnergyStar & water-saving fixtures/appliances



#### >Green Info Technology (Green IT)

- $\,\circ\,$  Data center upgrades
- Energy Star computer replacement program
- $\,\circ\,$  Server virtualization & data storage
- Remote power management

# **Renewables & Low-Carbon Fuels**

#### Solar Power Purchase Agreement (PPA)

- $\odot\,$  3.4 MW by end of 2012
- 6 locations (parking lots & rooftops)
- Annual energy generation can power over 500 homes

### **City Fleet - Alternative Fuels**

- LNG refuse collection trucks
- E-85 ethanol police cruisers
- Plug-In Hybrid EV Pilot Program
- Electric Bicycle Pilot Program
- $\circ$  7<sup>th</sup> best Green Gov't Fleet in U.S.



South Corp Yard Solar Project- Completed on December 2 2011





# **Efficient Transportation**

#### **City Fleet – Telemetrics**

 GPS Technology + integrated vehicle system monitoring
 Cuts fuel usage up to 25%

Full implementation by 2020



### Land Use & Community Design



### 2030 General Plan + Sustainable Communities Strategy (SB 375)

○ Infill-focus (2/3 of planned growth)

- Transit, bike & ped orientation
- $\circ$  Harmonizing land use & urban design



#### Green Development Code Update

- $\circ$  Flexible Parking Standards
- Low-Impact Dev. Standards (LID)
- $\circ$  Renewables, Energy Efficiency
- Efficient Review Process for Smart
  Growth & Infill



# **Open Space & Offsets**



#### Urban Forest Services

- Maintenance & Replacement
- Tree planting : 2,200 net increase/year
- Tree inventory & asset management (over 100,000)
- SMUD and Sac Tree Foundation: Shade Trees



### City Facilities: "Greenergy" and Carbon Offsets

- Over 750,000 kWh/year in Greenergy
- $\odot$  Sac Zoo: 100% offsets for all operations

- County-wide GHG inventory (Sac County + 6 cities)
- $\,\circ\,$  Regional GHG reduction measures analysis
- $\circ$  Best Practices, Info-Sharing
- $\circ$  Quarterly meetings

- Points & prizes for energy & transportation GHG reductions
