



THOMAS FIRE




Thomas Fire Conditions

- Total Acres Burned: 281,893
- Duration: Lasts almost 40 days
- Total Structures Threatened: 18,000
- Buildings Destroyed: 535 (504 homes)
- Buildings Damaged: 150 (140 homes)
- **Zero Lives Lost** in the City
- Successful Evacuations: 27,000 residents
- Staffing: 8,000 Firefighters
702 Agencies - 22 States




