Illinois: All Kids

The Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services administers the Illinois Medicaid Program and Children’s Health Insurance Program (CHIP).

Who Is Eligible?

A summary of eligibility requirements appears below. Be sure to check with the Department of Healthcare and Family Services to verify eligibility. Eligible individuals include:

- Children age 18 or younger who live in Illinois regardless of family income, immigration status or health condition.
