Who Is Eligible?

A summary of eligibility requirements appears below. Be sure to check with the Department of Health and Human Services Office of MaineCare Services to verify eligibility. Eligible individuals include:

- Children and teens age 18 and younger and pregnant women, based on income. For example, a family of four with a monthly income of \$ 3,334 monthly would be eligible.
