# Children's Health Insurance Information – Ohio

### **Ohio: Healthy Start and Healthy Families Programs**

The Ohio Department of Job and Family Services regulates the Healthy Start program (Ohio's State Children's Health Insurance Program) and the Healthy Families program (Ohio's Medicaid program).

#### Who Is Eligible?

A summary of eligibility requirements appears below. Be sure to check with the Department of Job and Family Services to verify eligibility.

#### Healthy Start Program

Eligible individuals include:

- Children younger than age 19 in families with income up to 200 percent of the federal poverty level (\$44,100 annually for a family of four in 2009 in Ohio); and
- Pregnant women in families with income up to 200 percent of the federal poverty level (\$44,100 annually for a family of four in 2009 in Ohio).

#### Healthy Families Program

Eligible people include:

- Families with a child younger than age 19; and
- Families with income up to 90 percent of the federal poverty level (19,845 for a family of four in 2009 in Ohio).
