Children's Health Insurance Information – Virginia

Virginia: Family Access to Medical Insurance Security (FAMIS)

The Department of Medical Assistance Services (DMAS) oversees the FAMIS program.

Who Is Eligible?

A summary of eligibility requirements appears below. Be sure to check with the Department of Medical Assistance Services to verify eligibility. Eligible individuals include children who:

- Are younger than age 19;
- Live in families meeting FAMIS income eligibility guidelines (for example, a family of four with an annual income of \$44,100;
- Live in Virginia;
- Don't have health insurance now and haven't had it in the past four months;
- Are not eligible for any Virginia state employee health insurance plan;
- Are not eligible for FAMIS Plus (also known as Children's Medicaid); and
- Are U.S. citizens or qualified aliens. Other children may be eligible; for more information, call the application assistance line at (866) 873-2647.
