At their meeting on January 26, 2010 the Board of Directors of the San Carlos Chamber of Commerce voted unanimously to endorse the San Carlos Mandatory Commercial Recycling Ordinance.

Since many of our members will be impacted by this ordinance, it was important for the Chamber to participate in discussions about the specifics of the program. We appreciate being part of the planning process and that you made sure our input was considered.

In addition, the pilot project last summer to introduce the concept of commercial recycling in San Carlos provided an opportunity for local businesses to experience first-hand what the program will ultimately look like.
