

Major Accomplishments for FY 2009-2010

Transportation Services

- Piloted a new County Center shuttle bus service in Oakland operating during morning and evening commute hours. The shuttle bus connects County employees to the local BART stations.
- Received grant funding of \$170,000 from the CMA for the launch of a new shuttle bus service to connect the JJC to the Bayfair BART station.
- Received grant funding of \$30,000 from the BAAQMD to purchase 15 new hybrid vehicles.
- Received grant funding of \$20,000 from CSAA for the conversion of a Sheriff's Dodge Dakota to an electric powered truck.
- Received grant funding of \$80,000 from the BAAQMD for the purchase of 40 electric charging stations. These charging stations will be installed in preparation of the new electric vehicles that will be available at the end of 2010.
- With eight additional hybrid vehicles this past year, 26% of our cars achieve an MPG of 30 or higher on the highway, a 3% increase over last year. Our fleet has 130 hybrid vehicles, 4 vegetable oil vehicles, and 170 fuel-efficient vehicles.
- Our Motor Vehicle shops have just been Blue Seal ASE certificated. This is the highest level of certification for automotive repair facilities.
- The Motor Vehicle Division was ranked in the top 100 government fleets in the nation for overall performance.
